Council considered the options for a new steel garage. <u>It was resolved that a 4.5m x 7.1m</u> <u>steel garage be purchased from Lifelong Steel Sheds at a cost of £10,673. The garage</u> <u>would have a manual roll up door and a side door. In addition four clear roof sheets</u> <u>would be requested at an additional cost and the colour would be anthracite.</u>
