

Agenda item F23.77: To Approve the Design & Location of the Dylan Memorial Zip Wire in the Park

SUMMARY

To approve the design and location of the Dylan Memorial zip wire in the park & memorial signage .

BACKGROUND

At the 27th September 2023 Facilities Committee meeting it was agreed that as the provision of a pump track was no longer financially viable the provision of a zip wire as the Dylan Memorial would be considered (minute F23.30v).

The proposed design and location are shown below.



This image does not show the start-off ramps which would be located at the end further from the path. The benches and bin will not need to be moved.

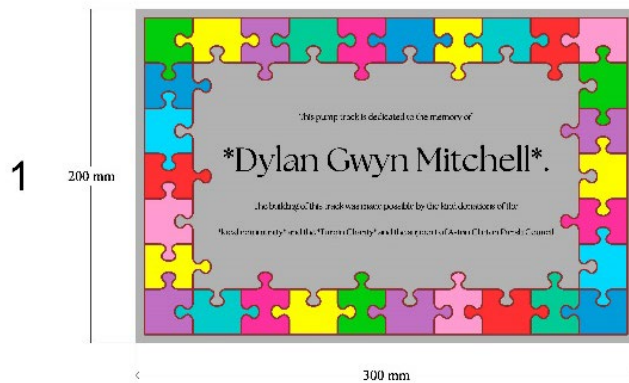


The two ramps will be set at the same end and will be as shown in the image on the left. The memorial sign can be affixed to either or both platforms. The posts can be one colour and the panel another (whichever the family wishes). Panels can be red, lime, green, turquoise, blue, orange or beige and posts can be light blue, red, yellow, grey, dark blue or brown.

The grass matting which is between the ramps in the photo will run the length of the track rather than the wet pour which is shown in the photo.



Below is a photo of the zip wire of similar design recently installed at Western Turville.



The draft of the memorial sign which will be placed on the ramps needs to be approved. The word “track” will be changed to “zip wire”. The coloured jigsaw border will be changed to be black and white.

Please note your order will not enter production until we receive your approval & payment. This in turn will mean your order will be delayed. Designs are drawn to scale however on screen colours are not an accurate representation of the actual product.
