**19.077 Declarations of Interest**

There were no declarations of interest.

**19.078 To approve minutes of the meeting held on 27<sup>th</sup> June 2019**

The minutes were proposed by Cllr Howard seconded by Cllr Ronson and AGREED and signed by the chairman.

**19.079 Public Participation**

Keith Loxley congratulated the Parish Council on getting the planning permission for the Community Centre.

**19.080 Temporary Accommodation**

Cllr Tubb explained to the meeting that planning permission had been received this morning from AVDC (Aylesbury Vale District Council). She also explained that the meeting had been called as at the Parish meeting of 8<sup>th</sup> May the Parish Council agreed that temporary accommodation could be ordered subject to planning permission having been granted and further, provided that the upfront deposit of no more than £17,000.

**MOTION:** to agree the placement of the temporary accommodation order, prior to formal planning approval, no longer needed.

The second motion to approve the upfront payment was discussed. Cllr Tubb explained that as the one contractor would now be providing the entire requirement, rather than splitting between separate contractors, the amount now required upfront in order to secure the buildings was for a total of £32,082.00. This would cover all installation, delivery and prelim costs. Without paying it, a delivery date could not be set and the project would over run.

Cllr Read stated that as we now have planning permission there is no risk in placing the order as the monies would have to be paid in any event. The Councillor's agreed.

**MOTION:** to approve the upfront payment to secure the order (in the amount of £32,082.00) was proposed by Cllr Judge, seconded by Cllr Mason and AGREED.
